Drunk Driving Statistics

1. A person in the U.S dies in Drunk Driving accident every 48 minutes
 2. The legal limit for Blood Alcohol Content is 0.8 but, ability to drive safely begins to be impacted at 0.2
 3. 1/3 of traffic fatalities are due to drunk drivers
 4. Men are 50% more likely than women to be driving drunk in a fatal crash
 5. 42% of drivers involved in fatal drunk driving crashes were ages 16-24
 6. Of all children killed in car crashes, 1/5 were due to alcohol
 7. Drivers with a BAC of 0.8 or higher that were involved in fatal crashes are 4.5 times as likely to have a prior DUI
